



Staffing



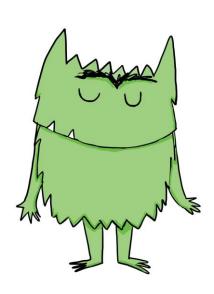
- I will be here all week with the exception of Wednesday afternoons for my PPA (planning, preparation and assessment) time. Children will be at Forest School / Nature School during this time.
- Miss Conder (soon to be Mrs Crook) will be here all week. She also works in Breakfast Club and as Lunch Time Supervisor.
- Mrs Finney is here Monday Thursday. During the afternoons she will be at Forest School with Foundation, Year 1 and our Year 2's.



A Day in Year 2



- Children will be met by me on the playground and then walked into the cloak room area where they
 will be further met by Miss Conder and Mrs Finney.
- Children will be responsible for bringing their book bags and water bottles into the classroom first thing in the morning.
- Lunch boxes will go on the trolley in the corridor.
- Children will then take their lolly stick and place it into one of our Colour Monster jars.
- During the day we will have movement and mindfulness breaks between sessions.
- Children have access to their water all day and are able to refresh and refill as needed.





Lunch and Break



- To ensure that children get the most out of each session, we do not have a fixed 15 minute break time in the morning.
- We usually aim for around 10.30am but this can vary as to our working pattern and load.
- During break, children have access to their drink and fruit which is available outside of the classroom.

Lunch time for Year 2 is 11.50am – 12.50pm





What does my child need to bring in?



- Children will need to bring in their book bags and water bottles daily
- Homework will be sent home on a Wednesday with spelling tests on a Monday
- A spare set of clothes is always useful, especially with changeable weather!
- Toys and jewellery from home often gets lost or misplaced so we discourage anything that is important / precious coming into school.

- Children can also aim for the Gold Board for going above and beyond for academic and other reasons.

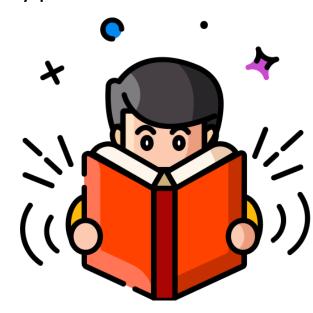




Reading



- Reading is an incredibly important part of children's learning
- We aim to hear all children read every week in Year 2. All reading will be recorded in your child's reading diary.
- To support your child, we encourage you to read daily with them, even if it is only 1 or 2 pages this all makes a huge difference. Please record any reading in diaries only 1 entry per day please.
- If a book is too challenging, try reading it first to your child, then reading it together before your child tackles it alone.





Homework



- Children will complete 3 enquiry based projects over the year. A covering letter in homework books and via Dojo explain when these projects are due.
- Each week, children will have spellings, a maths activity based on our in class learning and Timetable Rockstar / Numbots to complete.
- All children will need their homework books on Mondays
- We have three different spelling groups based on Phonics groups:

Spelling Bees, Spelling Sparks and Spelling Stars.





PE / Forest and Nature



- PE will take place on
 - Children will need to come in their PE kit on this day. This consists of:
 - Black shorts, leggings or jogging bottoms
 - Your child's Team Point colour T-shirt
 - Trainers
- Forest School / Nature School will take place on Wednesday afternoons.
 - Children will ne to come in the Forest School clothing for this day. This consists of:
 - Black joggers or leggings
 - School polo shirt
 - School jumper
 - Wellington boots
 - School provides overalls when they are needed
