Mrs Miozga will run cycling on Monday afternoons.

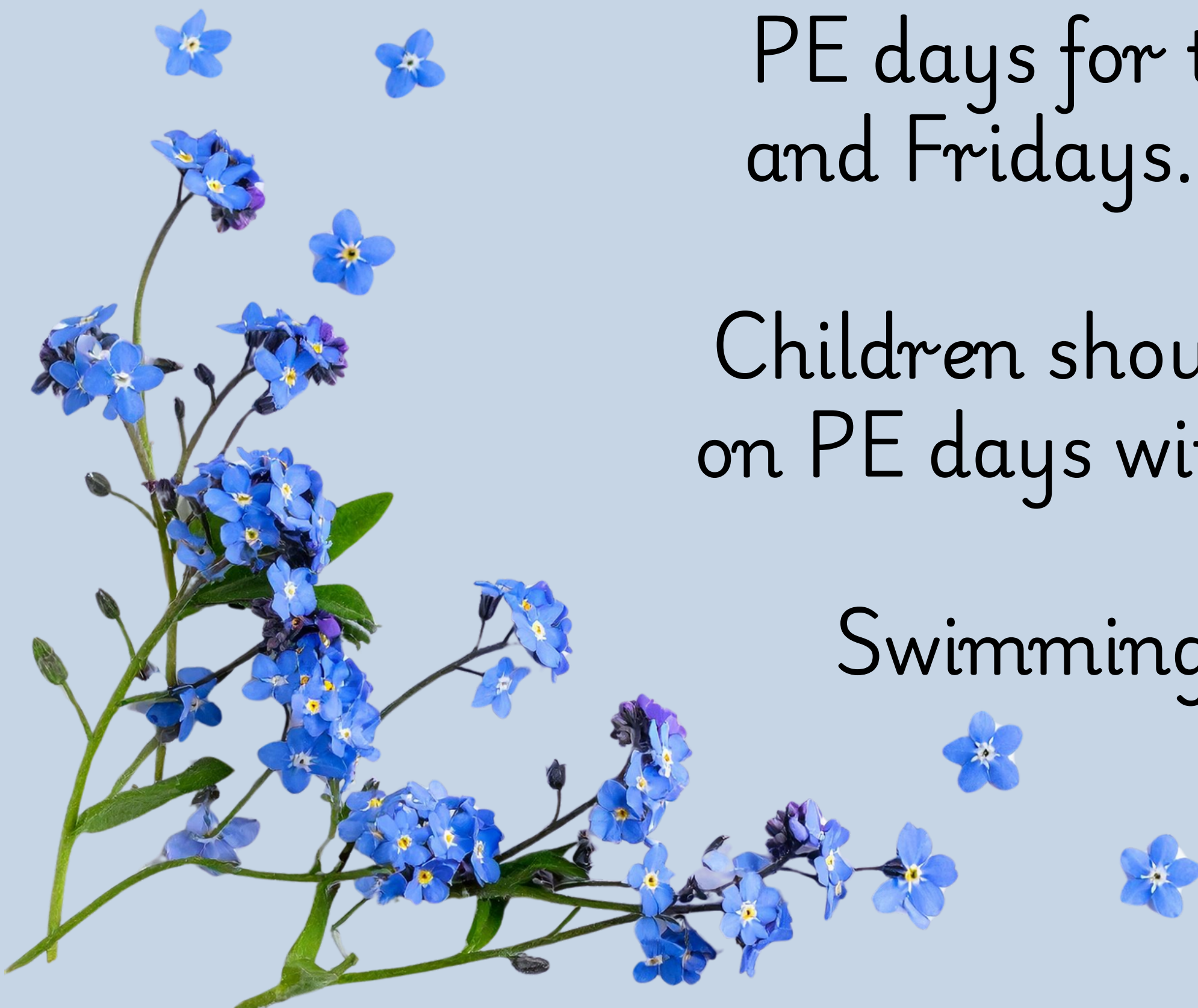


PE

- after half term, there will be a weekly SPaG activity

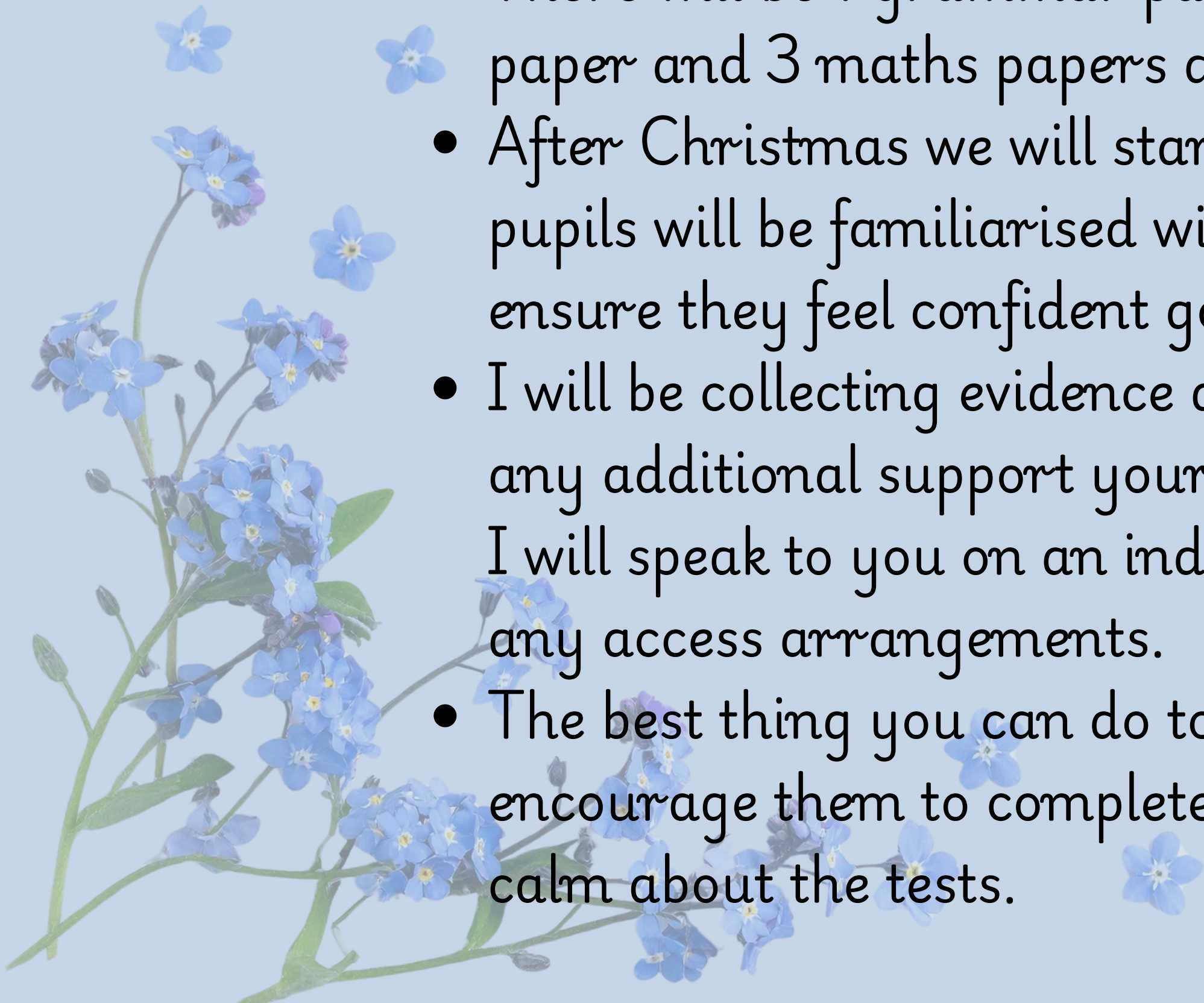
SPaG and Maths will be in CGP books from half term



SATS

SATs will take place on the week beginning 10th May.

- There will be 1 grammar paper, 1 spelling test, 1 reading paper and 3 maths papers across 4 days.
- After Christmas we will start to work on test technique and pupils will be familiarised with the format of the papers to ensure they feel confident going in to the week.
- I will be collecting evidence across the year with regards to any additional support your child may require for these tests. I will speak to you on an individual basis if I feel they will need any access arrangements.
- The best thing you can do to support your child is to encourage them to complete their homework but also remain calm about the tests.



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- SAT papers are marked by external examiners
 - We get the results back just before the end of the summer term and the result will be sent home with the end of year reports

The format of results is:

Your child has met the expected standard
or

Your child has not met the expected standard

Writing

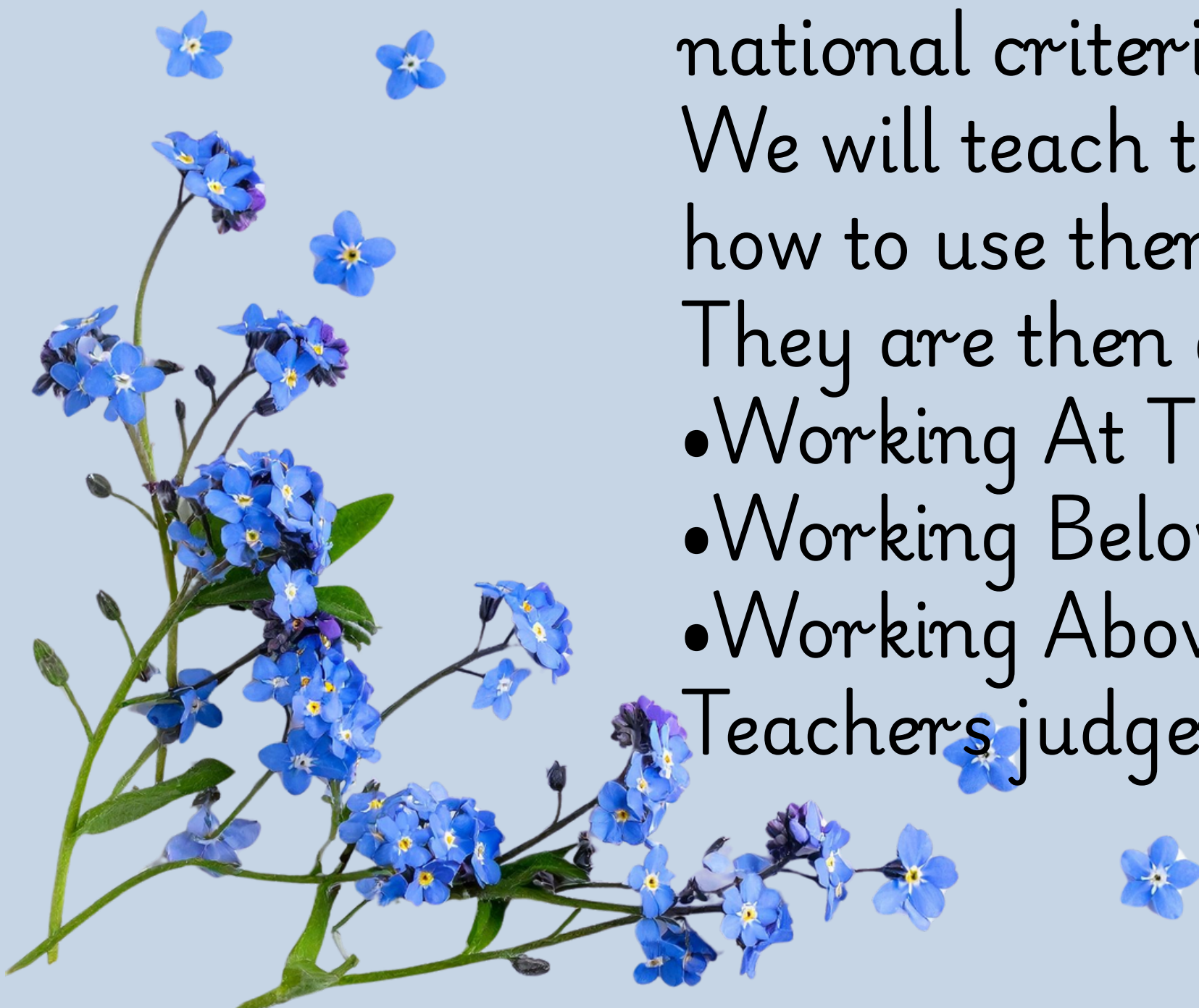
Writing is not assessed in a test format.

We will teach the children what the criteria mean and how to use them in their writing.

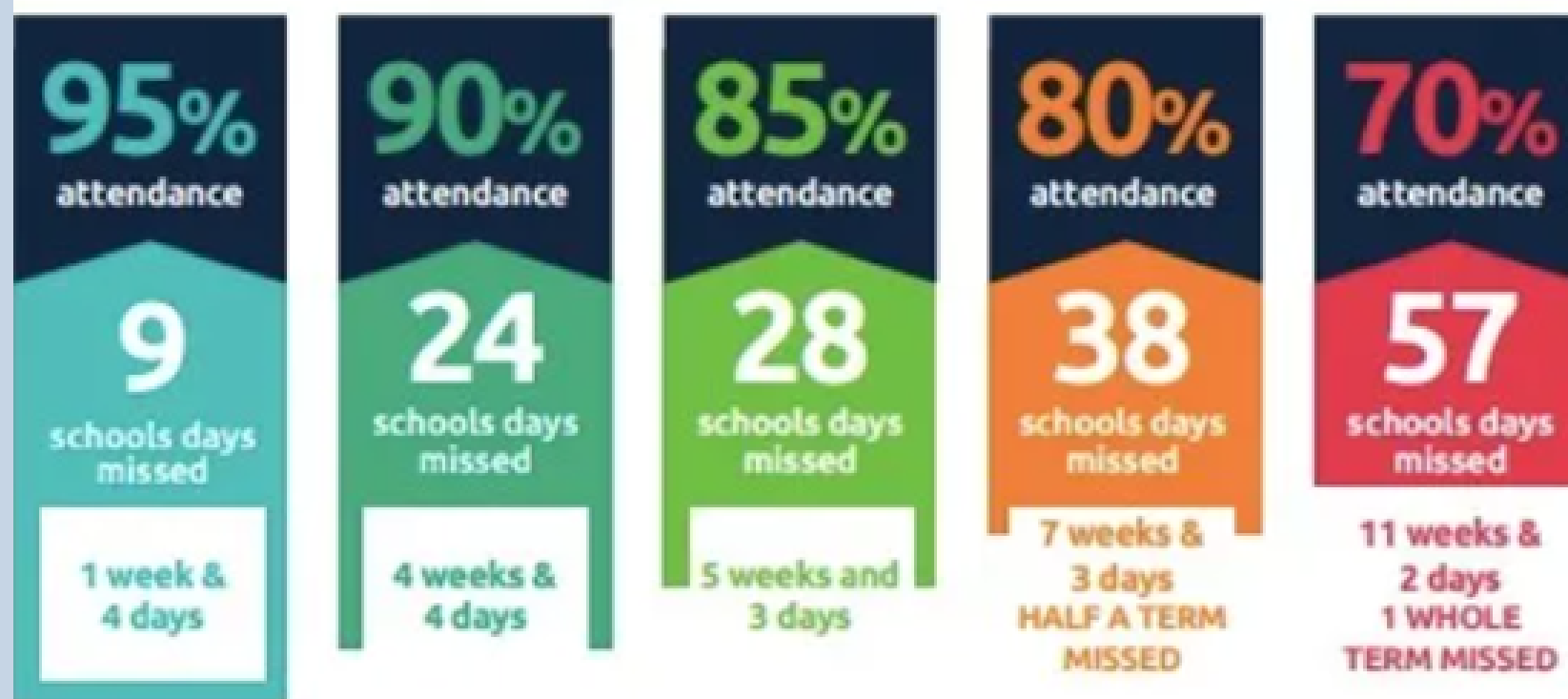
They are then given a result of:
